



Council meeting
April 8, 2024

The meeting opened at 7:05 with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Mayor asked if the council had looked over the March minutes and Sharon Johnson made a motion to approve the minutes. Eric Dailey seconded, and the vote was unanimous.

The Mayor moved on to the public forum which allowed a 3-minute comment. Scott Morgan spoke to the council concerning code violations at 898 Harrison Mill Road.

The Mayor opened discussion about the Local Maintenance Improvement Grant (LMIG) additional funds of \$18,329.21. He said his thoughts were to continue work on Shepherd Street, possibly widening the road to make it two lanes to the pavilion, then one-way from the pavilion to Star Street. Doug Koestel suggested also adding speed humps.

The council moved on to the Mutual Aid signatures. Tommy Buchanan moved that Sally Brown and Sharon Johnson be the designated signatures on both forms and the council agreed.

The Mayor asked to schedule a town hall meeting in May and the council agreed upon May 20th at 7 p.m.

At 7:25 Eric Dailey made the motion to adjourn, and the meeting ended.
