Feb. 2, 2026*

The meeting opened at 7:01 with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Sally Brown made a motion to accept Jan.26 minutes and Jan. 5 executive session minutes. Eric Dailey seconded and the motion passed with Doug Koestel and Sharon Johnson both voting yes.

Sally Brown made a motion to add an executive session concerning personnel to the agenda. Doug Koestel seconded the motion and the motion passed with Johnson and Dailey voting yes.

Koestel made a motion to add the vendor list to the agenda, Dailey seconded the motion and it passed with Johnson and Brown voting yes.

Attorney Jack Samuels swore in new councilman, Post 5, Mike Camp.

The business license for Strategic Concrete was approved with a motion by Koestel, a second by Johnson and a unanimous vote.
