

Town of Bethlehem

Council meeting

Jan. 4, 2021 @ 7 p.m.

Present: Mayor Sandy McNab; Councilmen, Joe Price, Tommy Buchanan, Scott Morgan, and Doug Koestel; Clerk, Kathy Bridges; Attorney Ron Bennett

Visitors: Clay McDaniel

The meeting opened at 7:15 p.m. with a prayer by Joe Price.

The Council heard from Clay McDaniel, a local citizen who wanted to combine a 10 acre tract to a 3.26 acre tract.

McDaniel was told that all he needed to do was have a surveyor to join the tracts and then have it recorded at the courthouse. The land is within the city limits of Bethlehem.

Tommy Buchanan made the motion to approve the December minutes and with a second by Doug Koestel the vote was unanimous.

Doug Koestel made the motion to sign the 2021 budget resolution and with a second by Tommy Buchanan, the vote was unanimous.

The council discussed adding cameras to cover the new playground. Mason Orr of Digital Creations suggested adding a 16 channel DVR (the current one is 8 channels) and adding 2 cameras to cover the playground; one camera to cover the walking track, 1 camera inside the shop and one camera inside the community room. The cost of a 16 channel DVR with 8-4K cameras is \$879. His labor to add these would be less than \$800.

The council wanted to be sure the playground cameras would work well with no light at the site. Scott Morgan made the motion to purchase the package and with a second by Doug Koestel the vote was unanimous.

The Mayor discussed the need to purchase a bucket truck and a tractor with a bucket on front and was told to check on prices.

At 8 p.m. the meeting adjourned.
